

## **SHOW RULES**

All of the exhibitors MUST have read the show rules before entering the show!!!

1. Any exhibit found not to be made/grown by the exhibitor will be disqualified.
2. All entries must be made on forms provided by the Committee.
3. The Committee reserves the right to withdraw or refuse any exhibit.
4. Bought flowers/foilage are only permitted in the flower arrangers classes.
5. The Judges decision is final in all cases.
6. All roots and tubers must be washed.
7. Nothing is to be removed from the show before the Presentations at 4pm. However all exhibits to be removed by 5pm.
8. All Exhibits will have visible numbers and no names to be on the exhibit.
9. The Committee reserve the right to move any Exhibit to assist in staging.
10. The Committee will not be held responsible for the theft or breakages of any entry.
11. All Exhibitors are restricted to only two exhibits per class.
12. Each item can only be entered in one class.
13. Entries will be accepted between 6pm & 7pm on Saturday 1st July and also between 9am & 11am on the morning of Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at the Wimblington Parish Hall. Doors open to the public at 2pm.
14. The following points are awarded for each prize winner in each Class. 1<sup>st</sup> place – 25 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 15 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 10 points.
  
15. Cups will be presented to Top Boy and Girl in each age group. A cup will presented to the Adult with the most points in each section. Then a cup to be presented to the child and adult with the most points accumulated during this year's show. Please return cups after the presentation to be engraved.
